 - Shared information on POS concerning Taylor County and new Quitline monthly flyer
 - 4th cheapest Blu disposable
 - Bedford & Lenox both have a retailer within 1,000ft of a school/park
- Jan Beach-Sickels – Taylor County Ambulance
 - Has taken over Adams County Ambulance service, but they are not merged
 - State has approved Narcan for all first responders, with a few limitations on who can administer
 - Family members of known drug addicts can also acquire
 - Recent rise of heroin
 - Waiting on new ambulance to arrive
 - New system to log into @ state
- Vicki Sickels – Quad County 4 Kids
 - Issued mini grant proposals for in home providers to help increase QRS
 - State looking to level funding
 - Lots of working coming around ACEs and educating people on what ACEs are
- Brittany Dorscher – Southwest Iowa Families
 - Started parenting classes in Clarinda
 - \$50 per session
 - Diaper Drive & Christmas Box Project winding down
- Lori Henrichs – Growing Strong Families
 - Currently serving 29 families
 - Prenatal through 5 years

 - Value added programs
