Welcome/Introductions

At 11:45 Debra Schrader opened the meeting and introductions were made. CHI Health Mercy Corning provided complementary lunches for those who reserved one.

Coalition Overview

Deb provided an overview of the Coalition and their work; to date the Coalition has been responsible for 1\$.2 million in grant funding.

Review of meeting minutes

The minutes of the January 4, 2024 meeting were reviewed and were accepted.

FY24 Mission and Ministry Violence Prevention Grant Update

Beth Roghair reported that prevention services will begin second semester in Lenox Schools and that they are confident they will meet contract benchmarks at the end of the fiscal year.

The FY24 CHI Health Mission and Ministry Violence Prevention grant is \$53,300 and Healthy Communities funding is \$16,000 of which 31.2% of grant funds have been expended.

FY24 Community Health Improvement Grant

Kristie Nixon reported that the grant funds have been received.

Health & Human Services Department Assessment

Information was shared about the realignment of the behavioral health assessment. Starting July 1, 2025, the current regions will be eliminated and 7 new regions will be implemented. The new region for Adams and Taylor County will have 17 counties in it. An RFP

will be released by HHS for a private, for profit, nonprofit, or 28E collaboration to apply to be contractor holder or Administrative Service Organization (ASO's).

HHS assessment on 19 programs was released January 5, 2024. The assessment is available online, it's unclear as to a timeline for implementation.

Kratom Training

Darla Dolecheck with ZION Integrated Behavioral Health provided a Kratom training for participants.
